CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** Age of entrants will be over 7 years and under 25 years as of the 1st January 2019. If the entrant is under 18 years then a parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. Younger persons are invited to attend as observers with strict parental supervision. Level of entrants experience must be stated on the entry form.
- 2.** All entrants 18 and over must sign the wavier form attached and return with entry. Under 18 entrants must have parent/guardian sign.
- 3.** Any disruptive or unacceptable behaviour as defined by the committee from any individual will not be tolerated. Such behaviour may result in disqualification from the competition and/or from the grounds.
- 4.** No alcohol is to be brought to the grounds by entrants. Individuals not abiding to this rule will face immediate disqualification and exclusion from the grounds.
- 5.** All entrants at all times are to obey the directions of the organising committee and are to remain on the grounds during the programmed times of the show. Only in exceptional circumstances and with parents/guardian approval, will an entrant be permitted to leave the showgrounds.
- 6.** There will be no smoking in the cattle sheds, toilets, eating area or sleeping area.
- 7.** Entrants are to wear neat, tidy clothes each day of the show. Adequate footwear must be worn at all times. All entrants will be required to wear the provided shirt during at least one competition.
- 8.** There is a limit of two animals per entrant. Extra entry fee applies. Loan animals will be free of entry fees and must be suitable to loan.
- 9.** Cattle ages will be taken from the 1st January 2019, Heifers without calves and steers (milk tooth & at least 50% Hereford) are eligible. Heifers must have a clear tattoo/ freeze brand identification. NO BULLS.
- 10.** The Committee will attempt to arrange the loan of a suitable animal for entrants needing to borrow an animal for the Show. Entrants needing a loan animal may need to share depending on the number of entrants.
- 11.** Allocated animals to be used in all show events.
- 12.** All electrical equipment must be tagged.
- 13.** Entrants must compete in all events to be eligible for major awards.
- 14.** Animals may arrive from 12 noon Friday 4th January and must be on grounds by 8am Saturday 5th January. Animals must be departed by 5pm Sunday 6th January, unless arrangements have been made with organising committee.
- 15.** All animals must have a NLIS tag.
- 16.** Owners of animals must complete attached National Herd health form and return with entry. All animals must be from a JBAS property score 6 or above.
- 17.** ALL CATTLE must be Pestivirus tested negative and all results to be submitted with entry forms.
- 18.** Liability in relation to any cattle remains with the owner. It is strongly recommended that livestock owners are covered by a current insurance that extends to shows.
