Herefords Australia Youth invites all young agricultural enthusiasts to attend the 2019 Herefords Australia Youth National Expo. This year's event will be held at the Parkes Showgrounds from Friday 5th of July to Sunday 7th of July 2019

This event has been designed to give young people the opportunity to build their knowledge and understanding of the beef industry, in a safe and welcoming environment. Activities will target all age groups and experience levels, with demonstrations ranging from halter making and knot tying to practical demonstrations on feed milling and nutrient conversions. We have placed a strong focus on ensuring that the demonstrations are age appropriate and that practical skill and knowledge will be able to be taken away from the event.

For those that don't have access to a suitable Hereford animal, there will be loan heifers available. Simply select 'Loan Heifer required' in the entry form and leave the rest to us.

Motel rooms have been reserved at a special rate at the International Quality Inn Parkes (02 6862 5222). Be sure to mention that you are attending the National Expo to receive the discounted rate. Conditions of Entry

- Entrants must be between 7 and 25 years of age as of 4th July 2019. If the participant is under 18 years of age it is required that a parent/guardian also sign the entry form. Younger persons are invited to attend as observers with strict parental supervision. Level of entrant's experience must be stated on the entry form.
- Participant must be or must become a
 Herefords Australia Youth member, in
 current financial standing, to compete at
 the National Heifer Show.Contact
 Herefords Australia to become a member
 or update your membership.
- 3. Whilst all reasonable precautions will be taken by the committee to ensure the safety of all attendees, each participant or parent/guardian signing this form agrees to indemnify the committee and Herefords Australia against any claim resulting from any accident or sickness that may occur at the event or associated with the event.
- Any disruptive or unacceptable behaviour as defined by the committee from any individual will not be tolerated. Such behaviour may result in disqualification from the competition and/or exclusion from the grounds.
- 5. No alcohol is to be brought to the grounds by entrants. Individuals not abiding to this rule will face immediate disqualification and exclusion from the grounds.
- 6. All entrants are to obey the directions of the committee and appointed supervisors at all times.
- 7. There will be no smoking in the cattle sheds, toilets, eating area or sleeping area.
- Entrants are to wear neat, tidy clothes each day of the show. Adequate footwear must be worn always. Neatness of attire will be a consideration in the Parader's Competition.
- 9. There is a limit of two animals per entrant over the age of 16
- Cattle ages will be taken from 1 July.
 Females, Bulls and steers are eligible. The
 following age limits apply: Females: 6-24
 months Bulls: 6-9 months Steers: up to 24
 months
- Bulls are to be handled by competitors of the ages 16 and over

- 12. The Committee will attempt to arrange the loan of a suitable animal for entrants needing to borrow an animal for the show providing a loan heifer form has been completed and returned. Every effort will be made to provide a suitable animal for every entrant who has completed this form
- Allocated animals will be used in all show events
- 14. All electrical equipment must have an inline circuit breaker and all power leads must have a current certificate from a registered electrician as required by law.
- 15. Entrants must compete in all events to be eligible for herdsman award.
- 16. Animals may arrive from 3pm Thursday the 4th July and all animals must be on ground by 8am Friday 5th July. Animals must be departed by 5pm Sunday 6th July
- 17. All heifers are to be under 24 months of age as of the 1st of July 2019 and **not** have a calf at foot.
- 18. Any females over the age of 24 months with a calf at foot, previously shown at any Hereford youth event will go into the Futurity cow class.
- 19. Steers are accepted but must be a minimum of 50% Hereford and showing no permanent teeth.
- 20. All animals (excluding steers) are required to be registered with Herefords Australia and be tattooed clearly and correctly.
- 21. All animals must have NLIS tag
- 22. All animals require a herd health form, which must include the Bovine Johne's Disease (BJD) status of your animals. Cattle will be stalled according to their BJD status, to comply with BJD MAP Regulations.
- 23. All animals must obtain a JBAS SCORE 6 or ABOVE.
- 24. All cattle must be Pestivirus tested negative and results provided with entry form.
- 25. Liability in relation to any cattle remains with the owner. It is strongly recommended that livestock owners are covered by a current insurance that extends to shows.
