The tattoo as observed is to be recorded on this form. If an animal presented for testing cannot be clearly identified, instruct the owner to seek advice from Herefords Australia Limited

The configuration of the tattoo is to be as follows:

- Breeder Code: 3 Alpha or Alpha/Numeric characters
- Year of Birth Code: M = 2016, N = 2017, P = 2018
- Calf Number: 3 numeric characters eg. 001...011...123

**This form must be lodged with the duty agent (Elders) by 22 April 2025.**

It is acceptable for the breeder code to appear in one ear and the year code and calf number to appear in the other ear.

**Minimum standard required for National Hereford Show & Sale (Wodonga).**

*1 - sample to be superficially free of blood and other contaminants including pus and flocculants.*

*2 - at least 30% of sperm to demonstrate progressive forward motility under the microscope*

**Notes.**

- (a) At the show & sale venue each bull will be subject to scrotal and testicular examination (including measurement and palpation) by the veterinarians appointed by the Management Committee with the opinion of the veterinarians on the day overriding any soundness certificate or semen report provided by the vendor.
- (b) If an unsatisfactory semen sample is collected at crush- side, the attending veterinarian or technician is advised to re-test the bull after 1 hour as the first sample collected from a sexually inactive bull may not be a representative sample. Furthermore, if the attending veterinarian or technician has doubt about the crush-side test result he/she is advised to request a laboratory examination of sperm morphology from:
